The requirements for religious organizations operating a child care facility are as follows: Facilities operated by a religious organization that receive federal funds for providing care for children must have qualifying background screening results for child care staff members at facilities operated by a religious organization and that do not receive federal funds for providing care for children are not required to have qualifying background screening results for all child care staff members of facilities operated by a religious organization that receive federal funds for providing care for children, with disqualifying background screening results are prohibited from being on the premises during child care hours.
